1-2 Thessalonians: Living the Future Now "The Art of Church Construction" 1 Thessalonians 1:1-10

How do you build a great church? How do you recognize a great church? What traits characterize a great church? Paul knew the answers to these questions and he often pointed to the church at Thessalonica as an example of a great church. Such a church is not defined by size or programming. Rather, a great church demonstrates a faithfulness that pleases God.
