POSITION TYPE: Part-time, Hourly, up to 20 hours/week

PURPOSE OF THE POSITION: The role of the Production Coordinator is to contribute to building a worship culture at BACC by project managing multiple teams, assisting the leadership of a campus, ensuring all worship experiences are executed with excellence, developing leaders & recruiting volunteers.

RESONSIBILITIES:

1). Annapolis Auditorium Production Leadership

- Maintains, evaluates, & facilitates scheduling of teams for weekend gatherings and other in-house production needs
- Assists in leading a team of technicians for all weekend gatherings
- Prepares production elements with excellence (lighting design, ProPresenter)
- Contributes to building a worship culture at BACC Annapolis campus
- Rehearses production team for worship gatherings
- Partners with other music and production staff to provide a unified team mentality
- Serves as a service producer, video director, and/or other production role on Sunday mornings
- Attends and participates in all Bay Area staff functions, meetings, events

Cross-Ministry Assistance

- Assists in coordinating production needs for other departments
- Assists in coordinating production needs for outside events (e.g., weddings, memorial services, etc.)

Team Building

- Assists Production Director in recruiting, training, and developing volunteers in production-specific areas for the Annapolis campus.
- Recruits, onboards and trains volunteers to provide fully staffed and capable teams.
- Establishes processes and systems under the leadership of the Annapolis Production Director that helps team members create a consistent high-quality production experience.
- Partners with other music and production staff to provide a unified team mentality

Equipment Management

- Oversees the purchase, maintenance, and operation of audio, video broadcast, lighting, and media production equipment for the Annapolis campus under the supervision of the Production Director.
- Develops detailed knowledge of operation and integration of all equipment.
- Creates and maintains an up-to-date inventory of equipment at the Annapolis Campus.
