

Today's Suggested Schedule—November 2025, Week 1

Monthly Bible Story: Elisha's Room • 2 Kings 4:8-17

Bible Words: *I will give thanks to the LORD with my whole heart. (Psalm 111:1 ESV)*

Bottom Line: You can thank God for everything.

Story Time

Gather children on a rug or in a specific area of the classroom to tell the story. Some children (especially the younger ones) may wander. That's okay. They're still listening and learning!

What You Need:

- Preschool Bible
- "Story Pictures" Activity Pages copied on cardstock

LEADER: "Hello, friends! I'm so glad to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today's true story from the Bible (*hold up the Bible*) begins with a man named Elisha. (*Hold up a picture of Elisha.*) Elisha loved God and traveled all over, telling people about God.

"In one town, there was a woman who helped Elisha by giving him food to eat. (*Hold up a picture of Elisha eating with the woman and her husband.*) But they wanted to do more to help him, so they built a room for him on top of their house and gave him a chair, a table, a lamp, and a bed. (*Hold up a picture of the man, woman, and Elisha standing next to the house.*) Elisha was so thankful that God gave him people to help him. God gives you people to help you, too! You can thank God for the people who help you because **[Bottom Line] You can thank God for everything.**"



Craft Time

Gather small groups of children around you at a table for toddler craft time. Depending on the size of your group, you may lead the craft two or three times. Not every child may want to participate in craft time. That's okay. Feel free to send home the craft materials for them to complete with their mom or dad.



What You Need:

- “Add the Room” Activity Page
- “The Room” Activity Page
- Glue sticks
- crayons
- Permanent marker

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Write each child's name on their paper.

During the Activity: Encourage children to color the pictures. Then help them to glue Elisha's room to the top of the house. Clean hands as needed.

What You Say:

During the Activity: “Look at your paper, there's the woman and her husband who helped Elisha! They would give him food to eat when he came to town. But they wanted to help Elisha even more! So they made a room on top of their house with a chair, a table, a lamp, and a bed so Elisha could come and rest. Let's add Elisha's room to the top of their house. *(Help rub glue on the back of the cutout and help position it on top of the house.)* Now pat it down to help it stick. *(Pause.)* Great job! Elisha thanked God for the people who helped him. You can thank God for the people who help you, too. **[Bottom Line] You can thank God for everything.**”
