Today's Suggested Schedule—November 2025, Week 2

Monthly Bible Story: Elisha's Room • 2 Kings 4:8-17

Bible Words: I will give thanks to the LORD with my whole heart. (Psalm 111:1 ESV)

Bottom Line: You can thank God for everything.

Basic Truth: God loves me.

Story Time

Gather children on a rug or in a specific area of the classroom to tell the story. Some children (especially the younger ones) may wander. That's okay. They're still listening and learning!

What You Need:

- Preschool Bible
- "Story Pictures" Activity Pages copied on cardstock

LEADER: "Hello, friends! I'm so glad to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today's true story from the Bible (hold up the Bible) begins with a man named Elisha. (Hold up a picture of Elisha.) Elisha loved God and traveled all over, telling people about God.

"In one town, there was a woman who helped Elisha by giving him food to eat. (Hold up a picture of Elisha eating with the woman and her husband.) But they wanted to do more to help him, so they built a room for him on top of their house and gave him a chair, a table, a lamp, and a bed. (Hold up a picture of the man, woman, and Elisha standing next to the house.) Elisha was so thankful that God gave him people to help him. God gives you people to help you, too! You can thank God for the people who help you because [Bottom Line] You can thank God for everything."







Craft Time

Gather small groups of children around you at a table for toddler craft time. Depending on the size of your group, you may lead the craft two or three times. Not every child may want to participate in craft time. That's okay. Feel free to send home the craft materials for them to complete with their mom or dad.



What You Need:

- "Light Switch Cover" Activity Page
- Ink pads or crayons
- Baby wipes
- Permanent marker

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Write each child's name on their paper.

During the Activity: Encourage children to press their fingertips on the ink pads, then press them all over their paper. Clean hands.

What You Say:

During the Activity: "I have a light switch cover for you to decorate today! Press your fingers in the different colored ink pads, then fill your paper with all the beautiful colors! (Pause.) Fill in the heart, too! (Pause.) Great job! (Clean hands as needed.) You can put it on the light switch in your room, and remember that [Bottom Line] You can thank God for everything. You can thank God for your room, the food you eat, family and friends, people who help you...EVERYTHING! In our true story from the Bible, Elisha thanked God for the people who helped him."
