Bible Story: Daniel and the Lions' Den • *Daniel 6*

Conversion Starter: When have you felt alone?

Bottom Line: God is always with you.

Monthly Memory Verse: *Those who trust in the LORD will receive new strength. They will fly as high as eagles. They will run and not get tired. They will walk and not grow weak.* Isaiah 40:31 (NirV)

SLIDE: Theme

OPENER

LEADER: "Hey, everybody! Welcome to Bedrock—where we're building confidence, block by block! I'm so glad you're here. Give me your best big wave! (*Wait and wave back.*)

"Today, we're going to have a lot of fun together! We'll play, sing, hear a Bible Story, and find out something amazing about God. If it's your first time here—welcome! You're already part of the crew.

"Hey, friends! I'm so excited to worship God through song with you! Worship is showing something is valuable to you, so there are a lot of ways to worship God! You can worship God by growing your friendship with Him—that's showing that you value Him. You can follow His ways and care for people like He does—that's showing that you value Him too!

"But right now, we're going to worship Him and show we value Him through music! This first song is about how we are children of a Father who loves us. We get to go through life loved by God! Let's sing about it in this first song: 'Yes I Am!'

"Great worshiping! It's true that God has asked us to live out His ways in our world, and that's a lot to do sometimes! But He promises that He will give us the strength to do it! That's what our Memory Verse this month promises. It's Isaiah 40:31! I will read it out loud, and then we can all say our Memory Verse together.

SLIDE: Memory Verse

"That's such a great truth to get into your heads and hearts!

“Great job, everyone! Today we’re going to look at the true story from the Bible of a man who was able to face something huge because he knew God was with him. Let’s go ahead and sit down and hear our true story from the Bible today.”

VIDEO: SO AND SO SHOW

LANDING

LEADER: “Wow! What an incredible adventure we just heard! Imagine Daniel, surrounded by the deep, echoing roars of lions, the darkness pressing in all around him. He must have felt scared, right? But Daniel wasn’t alone for even a second. Why? Because the God who created the universe—the God who made the stars and knows your name—was right there with him in that lions’ den!

SLIDE: BOTTOM LINE

“Let’s shout our Bottom Line together, with all the confidence of Daniel: ‘God is always with you!’ Ready? 1, 2, 3—”

LEADER and KIDS: God is always with you.

“That’s awesome! And guess what? That truth isn’t just for Daniel—it’s for you. Whether you’re laughing with friends at recess, sitting alone on the bus, facing a tough moment at home, or even lying awake at night feeling worried, God is right there. He promises that He’ll never leave you or abandon you. He’s always present, giving you strength and courage, just like He did for Daniel!

“Let’s think about our Conversation Starter for a second.

SLIDE: Conversation Starter

[Conversation Starter] “When have you felt alone?”

“Maybe it was your first day at a new school. Maybe you were sick, or someone let you down. Maybe your heart was pounding before a big test, or you moved to a new school and didn’t know anyone. Take a quiet second and remember how that felt.

“Daniel knew what it was like to feel alone, surrounded by people who didn’t believe what he believed. But Daniel knew he could talk to God anytime, anywhere. And so can you.

“No matter how alone you might feel, God is right there. You can talk to Him anytime—He’s always listening. Let’s chew on that Conversation Starter as we head to our Small Groups. And let’s pray together now.”

PRAYER

“God, thank You that You are always with us. When life feels scary or overwhelming, help us trust You, just like Daniel did. Help us remember that You go with us in everything we face, and may that give us confidence. We love You and we pray these things in Jesus’ name. Amen.”
