

# **Student Behavior Contract**

### WHAT WE EXPECT OF STUDENTS

The Released Time Bible Education opportunity is a gift from God, and it is the responsibility of all of us to use it wisely. We ask some basic things of you:

# **Common-Sense Rules**

- Be respectful of KHM staff/volunteers and fellow students.
- No rude gestures or negative comments.
- Keep this a safe place for everyone.
- Do not be disruptive.
- No cussing, fighting, yelling, talking out of turn, note passing, applying makeup, sleeping, etc.
- Be prepared. Bring a notebook, pencil, homework, etc. daily if required.

#### **Character and Conduct Rules**

All rules and disciplinary actions enforced by the public school that I attend remain in effect during this elective class period.

- 1) I will arrive at the designated area of the school on time and be ready to walk or be bused to site
- 2) I will keep my emotions under control, especially my anger. I will not act aggressively or become destructive when angry. Instead, I will instead talk about my feelings.
- 3) I will be honest in all of my interactions. I will not lie, cheat, or steal in order to get my needs met. I will not manipulate or be deceptive.
- 4) I will only use language that is appropriate. I will not curse or use insults.
- 5) I will not bully others and I will come to the rescue of another student, who is being bullied, by telling an adult or standing with the other student.
- 6) I will be patient, forgiving, and fair.
- 7) I will not have any personal electronic devices, including, but not limited to, cell phones, iPads, and iPods, which must be turned off during class and put away.
- 8) I will not leave the classroom except with permission from an approved adult.

## **Consequences for Failing to Meet Conditions:**

1<sup>st</sup> offense - I will be corrected and reminded of expectations.

2<sup>nd</sup> offense - A written warning will be given to me and my parent/guardian will be called and the school principal notified.

3<sup>rd</sup> offense - My parent/guardian will be called, and I will have to miss Released Time for one week and the school principal will be notified.

4<sup>th</sup> offense - I will be dismissed at discretion from Released Time classes for the rest of the school vear.
