Title: Called to Be Saints **Text:** 1 Corinthians 1:1-9

Big Idea: God is faithful to take messy people and turn them into his mighty saints.

REVIEW THE SERMON Why is it appropriate to call the Corinthian church a messy church?
In what ways is the church today (even our local church) a messy church?
Read 1 Corinthians 1:1-9. Why is First Corinthians relevant for our church and your life today? Why should you take this study seriously?
What does Paul mean when he says that the Corinthians are sanctified in Christ and called to be saints? Why should this provide hope for messy people in messy churches?
ASSESS YOUR LIFE How honest are you about the messiness of your own life before God, with others, and even with yourself? How do you try to stuff it, hide it, forget it? Why do you respond this way?
APPLY THE TRUTH What are the blessings Paul thanks God for in verses 4-9?
Which of these blessings give you the most comfort and encouragement amid your own messiness?
Identify three messy areas in your life. Do others know about them? What is keeping you from seeking help and accountability? What steps does God want you to take to really begin to deal with it and change? _
