Title: Wisdom of Men, Wisdom of God

Text: 1 Corinthians 1:18-31

Big Idea: Though the cross of Christ is foolishness to the world, it is the wisdom and power of God for

salvation to all who believe.

## **REVIEW THE SERMON** Read 1 Corinthians 1:18-31. What does our culture identify as the most important qualities in someone successful, and how is that different from what God says? Why do the Jews stumble over the Gospel and the Gentiles think it is foolishness (vs. 18, 22-23)? How do you see similar responses in people today? How might the church compromise the Gospel to make it more appealing to the world? What's wrong with this approach? \_\_\_\_\_ How does Paul prove the power and wisdom of the cross? Why did God choose the foolish, weak, and lowly to be his people and display his power (vs. 27-29)? What is the only thing a Christian can ever really boast about (v. 31)? **APPLY THE TRUTH** In what ways are you tempted to place your hope and trust in your own wisdom, skill, power, or abilities? Why is truly foolish? Have you ever been hesitant, afraid, or ashamed to share the gospel? Explain why. How do the truths in this passage strengthen your confidence and resolve to boldly proclaim the word of the cross?
