A SUFFICIENT WARNING: SATAN'S SEDUCTION

2 Corinthians 11:1-4



BIG IDEA: Satan is trying to seduce us away from a sincere and pure devotion to Christ.

APPLICATION GUIDE

September 11, 2022

DISCUSS

In what ways were the Corinthians flirting with Spiritual adultery?

What are the similarities between Eve's deception by the Serpent and Paul's feared Corinthian deception (Genesis 3:1-7)?

What other ways are we easily seduced away from Christ and into sin (James 1:13-15; 1 John 2:15-17)?

APPLY

How might Satan seduce you into believing in a different kind of Jesus?

Why is the real Jesus infinitely better?

What kinds of ungodly thoughts or attitudes might a different spirit lead you?

How can yielding your heart to the Holy Spirit lead you in the right direction?

How confident are you that the gospel you believe and proclaim is true? Write out a simple gospel statement that would lead someone else to the forgiveness of sins and eternal life.

COMMIT

Rehearse the gospel every day this week and freshly apply it to your heart. Use these passages to help: John 3:16-18; Rom 3:23-25; 5:1-2, 8-9; 10:8-9; 2 Cor 5:21; 1 Tim 1:15; 2:5-6; 1 Peter 2:24-25; 3:18; 1 John 1:9-2:2.
