**Title:** The Resurrection Described

Text: 1 Corinthians 15:35-58

**Big Idea**: The glorious nature of our future resurrection fuels our work for the Lord here and now.

## **DISCUSS THE ISSUE**

Why can thoughts about the resurrection be so comforting to those facing a soon and certain death?

Make a list of the most common questions people ask about the resurrection and our glorified bodies?
