4.	Write down a few examples from Scripture where you see God's power at work in the weakness of his people (e.g. Exodus 3:11-12; 4:1-17; Judges 6:11-16; 7:1-25).
5.	Can you think of a way Christ's power rests upon you because of your weakness? How can you gladly boast of your weakness? What does it reveal about your heart if you simply cannot receive weakness with joy?
