Title: Keeping Your Quest for Approval in Check

**Text:** 1 Corinthians 4:1-5

Big Idea: We're often very concerned with what people think of us, but it's what God thinks that should

matter most.

REVIEW THE SERMON  How do you want to be regarded at the end of your life? What kind of epitaph do you hope to have written about you?
Read 1 Corinthians 4:1-5. What does it mean to be regarded by others as a servant and steward?
How does God define success (v. 2)?
Why should God's opinion of you matter more than the opinions of others (v. 5?
ASSESS YOUR LIFE  Evaluating your faithfulness can be difficult if you have the wrong standards. What faulty standards do you tend to use most (functions, formulas, feelings, feedback, fantasy, others)?  What is a biblical standard you can use to evaluate your faithfulness? How should this help you find freedom from being a slave to the approval of others?
APPLY THE TRUTH  Think of a person in your life from whom you desire approval? How do you want them to regard you? How do your desires make you a slave to them instead of a servant of Christ?
How can you view this relationship in terms of being a servant of Christ and a steward of his word?
