Title: Reasons for Remaining Single

Text: 1 Corinthians 7:25-40

Big Idea: Singleness isn't often seen as a plus, but in some circumstances, it can be the best option for securing a undivided devotion to the Lord.

REVIEW THE SERMON Read 1 Corinthians 7:25-40. Describe the big idea of this text in your own words?
Why might singleness sometimes be viewed as a burden, not a blessing?
Paul calls singleness a "better" (v. 38) and "happier" way (v. 40). How can Paul elevate the blessings of singleness without belittling the blessings of marriage?
ASSESS YOUR LIFE
What perspective can help you serve God effectively whether you are married or not (v. 29-31)?
APPLY THE TRUTH What unique pressures of life are you facing right now, and how is God providing for you either through your marriage or through your singleness (v. 26, 28)?
How should the fact that "time is short" (v. 29) affect your priorities and actions right now?
What kinds of things in life try to pull at your heart and divide your devotion to the Lord (v. 35)? How can you guard against those things and remain fully devoted to him?
If you're married, how can you encourage and support the single person? If you're single, how can you encourage and support the married person?
