How does Christ's work change the way you relate to other believers regardless of the differences (Acts 2:39; Colossians 1:9-14)?

How have you seen God draw you close to him?

How can those experiences help you draw close to other believers, even if they are very different from you?

What steps do you need to take to draw even closer to God (Deuteronomy 4:29; Hebrews 4:16; 7:25; James 4:8)?

Don't seek God alone and don't always seek him with people just like you. See him with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart no matter who they are (2 Timothy 2:22).
