APPLICATION GUIDE

REVIEW THE SERMON

Read John 11:1-44. What does this chapter tell you about who Jesus is and how he works in the lives of his people?

Explain what Jesus means when he says, "Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die" (v. 25-26).

What was one idea in the sermon that had the most impact on you?

APPLY THE TRUTH

Can you of a time in your life when you asked the Lord for help, but it seemed as if he didn't hear or wasn't even there? How did you respond? What did God ultimately teach you through it?

How can you allow illness or other tragic circumstances in your life to be a means of bringing glory to God instead of growing angry and bitter (v. 4)?

When have you responded with fear to something God asked you to do? How does fear affect your faith and your behavior? How has God proven himself faithful in the midst of your fear?

How can you respond to disappointment with the same kind of faith that Martha did (v. c. 21-22, 24, 27)? Is there a situation in your life that you can apply this too right now?

How can the truths about Jesus in this this passage help you overcome doubt in any situation (v. 40)?
