Three Attitudes of Sanctification 1. Reckoning (vs. 5-11) • We are *united* with Christ (v. 5). We are *crucified* with Christ (vs. 6-7). • We are *alive* with Christ (vs. 8-10). 2. Yielding (vs. 12-14) 3. Serving (vs. 15-23)

MAKE IT REAL

4.	What sins might currently have you enslaved? How does your identity in Christ change the way you approach that enslavement?
