
SERMON NOTES

2.	How should the fact that God doesn't condemn you for your sin impact the way you respond to the sin of others (cf. Matthew 18:21-25; Ephesians 4:32)?
	What is the difference between <i>condemning</i> someone because their sin and <i>confronting</i> them?
3.	Is there anything that keeps you from being real, honest, or confessing your sin to others? How should the reality of being freed from condemnation impact the level of vulnerability and intimacy you share with other believers?
4.	In what way(s) will knowing that Jesus' ministry was in order to make you holy motivate you to live differently today?
