Big Idea: Living missionally means cultivating a meaningful gospel presence in the lives of the

people in our circles of influence.

I. A Prayerful Presence (2-4)

- A. Its Character
 - "steadfastly"
 - "being watchful"
 - "with thanksgiving"
- B. Its Content
 - "that God may open a door for the word"
 - "to declare the mystery of Christ"
 - "that I may make it clear, which is how I ought to speak"
- II. A Wise Presence (5-6)
 - A. "making the best use of the time"
 - B. "let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt"
 - C. "so that you may know how you ought to answer each person"
