Title: Rejoice, the Lord is King **Text:** Matthew 21:1-10; Psalm 24

Big Idea: What does it mean that Christ is King?

REVIEW THE SERMON Why were the people so excited to see Jesus enter Jerusalem before the celebration of Passover?
What were the differences between the expectations the people had for Jesus and the plan God had for him as he came into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday?
ASSESS YOUR LIFE There are only two kingdoms in this world, the kingdom of self and the kingdom of God. What keeps you from serving God's kingdom and serving your own kingdom instead?
APPLY THE TRUTH Why is the battle over the origin of the universe so important in our world today? What might cause the church to win or lose this culture battle, and what hope do we have in Christ?
What is the royal standard for standing in God's presence according to v. 3-4? Repent of anything that would compromise your inner or outward integrity and hinder your ability to come before God in true worship (cf. Is. 57:17; 66:2).
According to vs. 5-6, how can you be certain that you will be received by the King?
One day Jesus will come again and rule as King of everything. What should your attitude be as you wait in anticipation of that day (Mt 24:41-52; Luke 19:13-18; 2 Tim. 4:8)?

COMMIT THIS WEEK

Spend some time preparing your heart for the Easter celebration beginning this week. Reflect on the relationship between his rights as King and the sacrifice he made for sinners in obedience to God.
