STUDY GUIDE

REVIEW THE SERMON Read Romans 12:9-10 and 1 John 4:7-12. Why is love such an important ingredient in a Christian's conduct toward other believers?
Describe the quality of love believers ought to show one another.
What is the difference between the worlds view of tolerance and biblical love?
ASSESS YOUR LIFE Just as a butterfly goes through a physical process of transformation, so Christians go through a spiritual process where they grow from the new birth into a mature follower of Christ. Where do you think you are in that process of spiritual transformation, especially as it relates to your love for other believers? What are some of your greatest hindrances to spiritual transformation?
APPLY THE TRUTH Our love for others must be "genuine" and "brotherly." Is there another believer in your life that you struggle to love this way? What needs to change in your perspective or actions toward them?
Choose at least one of the other characteristics of Christian conduct in vs. 9-13 and work on developing it. What steps toward change can you take this week?
