Series: Uncommon Community Title: Serve One Another **Text:** Galatians 5:13-15 Big Idea: Serving is not easy, but when we remind ourselves of our identity in Jesus, serving become part of who we are. 1. Called to Freedom 2. Free to Serve 3. Serve through Love

Read Galatians 5:13-15. Paul says that we are "called to freedom." What are we free from and free now to do?
Why does Paul warn us against using freedom as an opportunity for the flesh? What is an opportunity for the flesh as it applies to situations of freedom (wise verses unwise) rather than a biblical command (sin verses not sin)?
What is the connection between serving and love? What happens if service happens but love is not present?
ASSESS YOUR LIFE What hurdles often keep you from serving others? What excuses do you make? How might this reflect a worship problem in your heart?
APPLY THE TRUTH How can you serve others in your small group relationships and encourage others to join you?
What person in your life needs you to use your freedom to serve them? What can you do specifically in the next week or on a regular basis to meet their needs?
