REVIEW THE SERMON What does water baptism symbolize in the life of a believer?
Why should only a believer be baptized?
ASSESS YOUR LIFE
Water baptism is an outward symbol of an inner spiritual reality. It illustrates our death with Christ and resurrection to new life. Do you think of your Christian walk in these terms? Do you see yourself fully immersed in Christ and raised with him, or just partially?
What difference should your spiritual baptism in Christ make in your practical daily life (1 John 1:7)?
APPLY THE TRUTH
Why does the mode of baptism matter? For example, what difference does it make whether a person is sprinkled or immersed?
How would you respond to the idea that baptism saves or is necessary for salvation (cf. Mark 16:16; Ephesians 2:8-9)?
