Authorship

~ Who exactly wrote the Book of Revelation ~

Facts We Know:

- Name is "John" (1:4, 22:8)
- Identifies as Jesus' servant (1:1)
- Faithful Witness for Jesus (1:9)

Reasonable Assumptions:

- · John is well known and recognized
- Likely visited Asia Minor

Possible Authors:

- John (12 Disciples)
- John Mark (author of Gospel Mark)
- Elder John (mentioned by Papias)
- Pseudonymous

Early tradition is <u>unanimous</u> in its opinion that the Apocalypse was written by John the Apostle.

(Justin Marytr, Eusebius, Irenaeus, Clement of Alexandria, Carthage Tertullian)

Dating Revelation

~ During what time period was this book written ~

- "Caesar Nero" = "666"
- The "Temple" still exists
- Predicts fall of Jerusalem in ZOAD
- Nero resurrection myth

- More widespread persecution
- Spiritual decline in the 7 Churches
- Heretical groups (Nicolaitans)
- Comment by Irenaeus

We will not, however, incur the risk of pronouncing positively as to the name of Antichrist; for if it were necessary that his name should be distinctly revealed in this present time, it would have been announced by him who beheld the apocalyptic vision.
