Key Areas of Responsibility

1. Youth & Family Ministry

- Lead current ministries and create new ones for youth and families in our congregation
- Foster a welcoming environment where young people can explore faith, build friendships, and serve others
- Build relationships with new and current students and their families through personal engagement, school visits and attendance at events
- Recruit, train, and equip volunteers and peer leaders for all youth and family programs
- Collaborate with parents as partners in faith formation and provide resources to strengthen family discipleship

2. Administration & Communication

- Coordinate calendars, events, and communications for youth and family ministries
- Manage budgets responsibly for related programs
- Communicate regularly through emails, phone calls, announcements and social media
- Collaborate with church staff and ministry teams to align all efforts with FELC's mission:
 Reaching Wider, Growing Deeper, Loving Stronger
- Write reports as requested by Pastor

3. Worship Leadership and Teaching

- Preach Christ-centered message on a regular basis, and occasionally guide youth-led worship
- Teach youth Bible studies weekly and team-teach confirmation and first communion with the senior pastor
- Attend meetings as requested by Pastor
