



Pastoral Residency Overview Carlton Landing Community Church

Description: The Pastoral Residency at Carlton Landing Community Church combines theological education, pastoral training, and real ministry experience. In partnership with Oklahoma Baptist University, students complete a semester of coursework while serving on the church staff, receiving tailored academic training and mentorship for a life in ministry.

Location: Carlton Landing Community Church (on-site)

Duration: Summer or Fall Semester

Time Commitment: Full-Time Student, Part-Time Ministry Resident

Reports To: Dr. Cole Feix

Roles and Responsibilities:

- *Ministry Training:* Pastoral Residents participate in the life of the church like a staff member, attending all programming, working on projects and objectives, serving throughout the week, and learning how to lead a church. Residents will attend church services, meetings, programming, and events.
- *Education:* Each Resident will have a course schedule coordinated with OBU and must maintain full-time status for the duration of the residency. These courses will be tailored to the students' needs and overseen by the Senior Pastor.
- *Development:* During the week, students will meet with the Senior Pastor and staff for discussions, development, and discipleship.

Qualifications:

- This residency is aimed at young, high-capacity ministry leaders who plan to serve in vocational ministry.
- Candidates are chosen based on their experience, goals, and coursework needs.
- The residency is open to men and women.
- Ministry degree program preferred.

Provided:

- Residents will be provided with housing in Carlton Landing.
- Part-time job opportunities are available as needed.
- Resources, books, and developmental materials.

Expectations:

- Residents must sign and affirm Carlton Landing Community Church's [Statement of Belief](#).
- Maintain a growing spiritual life, walking in a manner worthy of the gospel. (Col. 2:6).
