"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." -John 10:10

Whether it's a constant worry always in our faces or a nagging concern in the back of our minds, God's truth is that life doesn't have to be like this. He's got a sleep-in-the-storm rest with our names on it.

We don't have to make do with anxious feelings nor do we have to accept fear as our lot in life. We don't have to learn to get used to this frantic worry and pain as the reality of life. A close walk with God is a life where worry and fear have no power. Yes, they will knock on the door of your heart and attempt to trouble you but they can't come in and out as they please anymore. Not when there's a new guard of your heart who will help you deal with them.

The creator of the heavens and the stars can handle what feels like the weight of the world on us. We will always be able to come out of our struggles with a strength and joy we didn't know was possible. Our God is a God who works wonders in the unseen. Right here, right now, I encourage you all to let God be God. Let Him fight your battles. He is bigger than any problem.

The promises of God may seem fleeting or unrealistic but if we hold Him to His word, His intense love for us and His faithfulness to His word will come through for us. May we all cast our cares to Him, even through the faintest prayers!




To My Saint Luke Friends:

We can accept these for 4 months beyond the expiration dates as the military commissaries will accept them. Please DON'T recycle these with your weekend papers. Bring them to the closet in the Williams Lobby and leave them in the marked container. Over the years we have received letters of thanks from various military bases in Great Britain, Europe and Asia, telling us that our work here is appreciated. A special word of thanks to Phil Bradley who collects them after the Men's Prayer Breakfast and brings them to me.




