

Sermon Text Ephesians 1:3-10

³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, ⁴ even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love ⁵ he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, ⁶ to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved. ⁷ In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, ⁸ which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight ⁹ making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ ¹⁰ as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in Christ, things in heaven and things on earth in him.

Questions for Families and Community Groups

Advent Series · Before There Was Time · Ephesians 1:3-10

- 1. For Children:
 - a. Why is God's greatest gift, Jesus, better than any Christmas present?
 - b. One day Jesus will come again and make right everything that has gone wrong. "Everything that is sad will come untrue." What are you looking forward to seeing Jesus put right when He comes again?
- 2. How does it help you to know that God has chosen you to be holy and blameless before Him?
- 3. How does this passage transform how we think about worldly identities and sources of meaning?
- 4. How would you use this passage to help a friend who is anxious about news and world events?
- 5. This passage shows us that God accomplishes his redemptive purposes at just the right time in history. What has helped you to trust God's timing in your life?
- 6. Why is Paul so exuberant in these verses? How do the truths here lift your heart to bless God?

All of us encounter things which are a concern for us. These might be personal needs or the needs of family members or friends.
