# Hypostatic Union

Christ's human nature and divine nature is unified in one person.

Col. 2:9 "For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells bodily"

**Human nature**

**Human will**

“not my will, but yours be done”

**Human attributes**

(birth, growth, exhaustion, sleep,  
hunger/thirst, emotions, temptation,  
suffering, death)

# Deity

**Divine nature**

**Divine will**

“you loved me before the  
foundation of the world”

**Divine attributes**

(omnipotence, omniscience,  
omnipresence, forgives sins,  
wisdom, love, sinless)

2 natures. 1 person. Undivided.

1 John 4:1-3

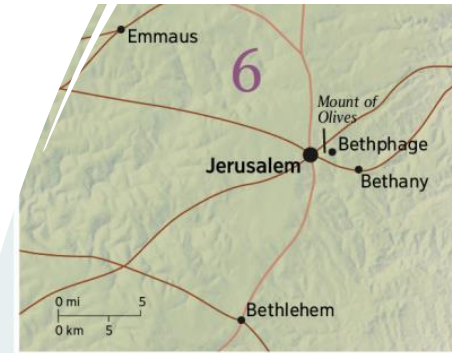
Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world. <sup>2</sup>By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God; <sup>3</sup>and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God; this is the *spirit* of the antichrist, of which you have heard that it is coming, and now it is already in the world.

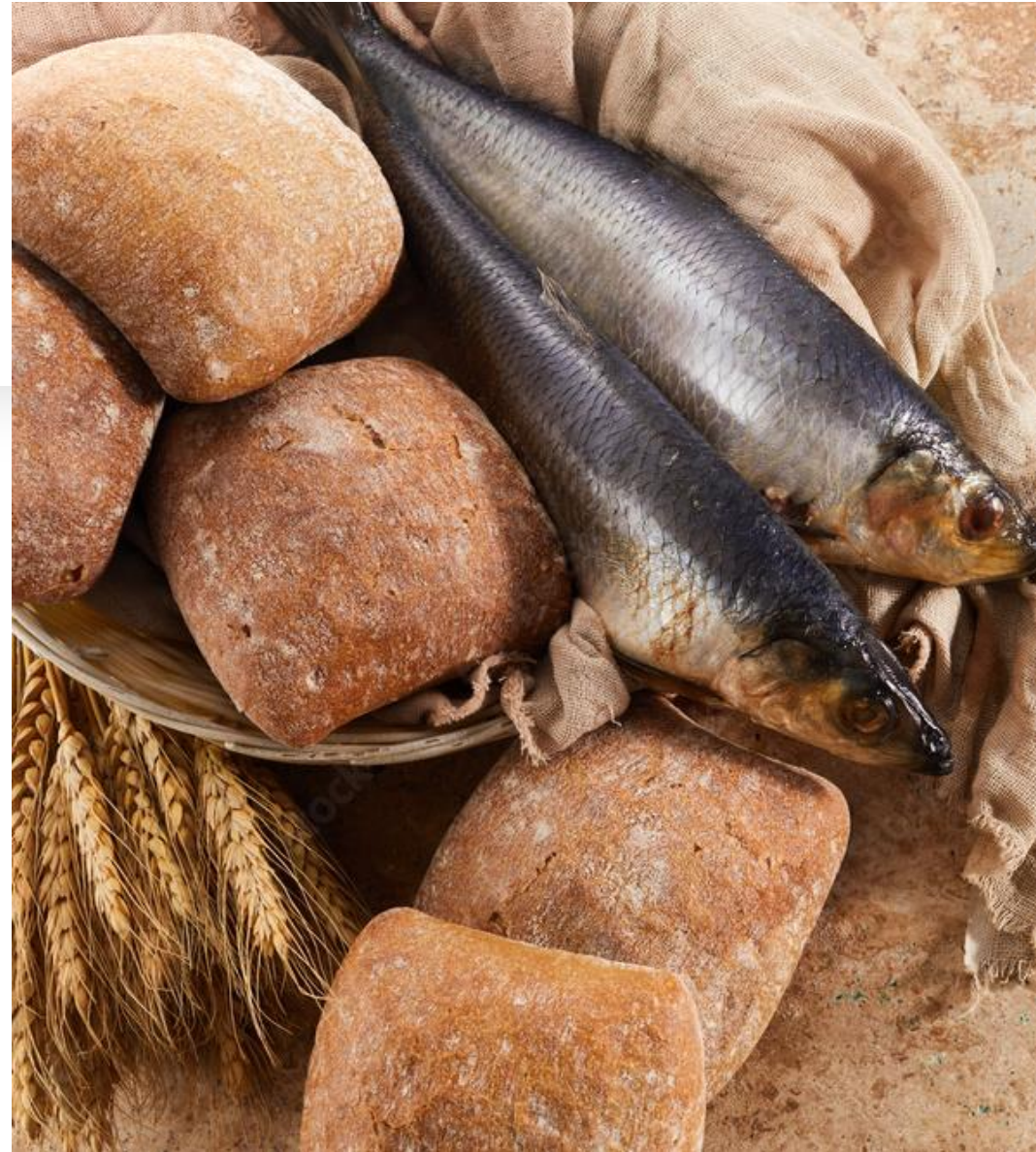
# Miracles

4 So Jesus, knowing all the things that were coming upon Him, went forth and said to them, “Whom do you seek?”

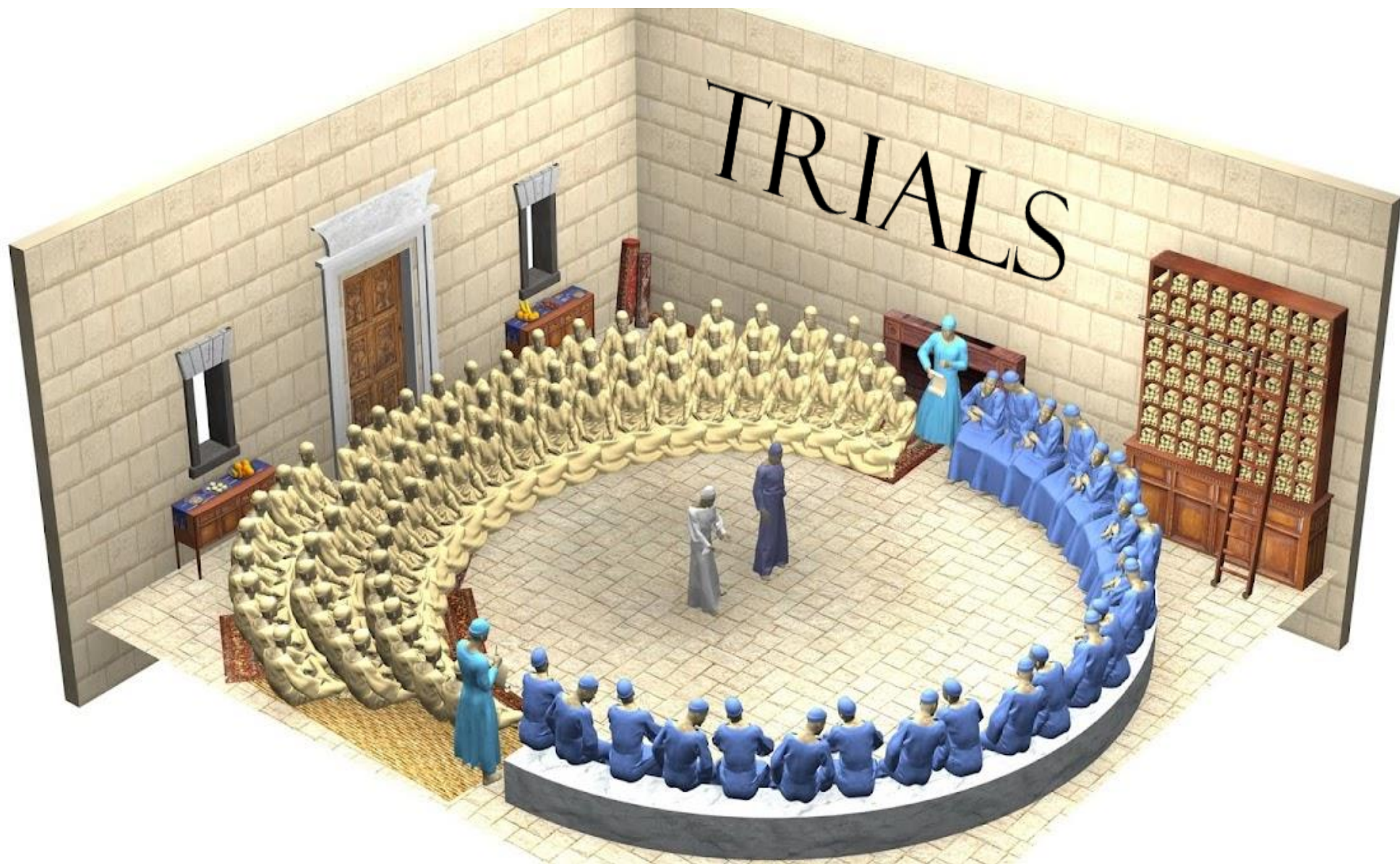
5 They answered Him, “Jesus the Nazarene.” He said to them, “I am He.” And Judas also, who was betraying Him, was standing with them.
