



We want to give you a big picture **framework** or **grid** for you to place the small pieces or details of the Bible


Think of it like ...

1. Scripture originates from God

2. Human authors were “carried along” by the Holy Spirit

3. The Holy Spirit “carried along” the authors to ensure accuracy

4. Inspiration extends to all Scripture, not just parts of it.
