Prayer Prompts

9:00-12:00 pm: Prayer for God's Anointing

Prayer Prompts

Psalm 51:1-12 • Acts 1:6-14 • Acts 4:23-31

This block of prayer is a great time of day to ask for God's forgiveness and to invite the Holy Spirit to come and fill your life. Spiritually prepare by inviting the Holy Spirit to lead you into service for God in your day.

- Ask God to point out any specific or hidden sin in your life to confess and be cleansed from.
- Ask God to point out any specific or hidden sin at Grace to confess and be cleansed from.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you with his anointing and to lead you into his ministry work today.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to fill Grace congregation with his anointing for the work of ministry.
- Pray for God's wisdom, discernment, and guidance to the leadership of the church.
- Pray for God's manifested presence at Grace.
- Pray for opportunities to become a witness for God.
- Pray for boldness in sharing the love of Jesus with others.
- Pray for the Spirit to gift you in ways that will glorify God.

12:00-3:00 pm: Prayer for the Nations

Isaiah 2:1-5 • Matthew 28:18-20 • Revelation 5:6-10

Use this block of prayer to think of individuals or people groups who do not believe in Jesus. And pray that they would experience the living water of Jesus.

6:00-9:00 pm: Prayer for Deliverance

Prayer Prompts

Psalm 31:1-6 • Daniel 3:14-18 • Acts 12:1-19

It was during this watch that the Passover occurred, reminding the Israelites of God's deliverance and protection in their lives through the exodus. It is a time to pray for your children, the next generation, that God would protect and deliver them from Satan's temptations and attacks.

- Pray for those who need deliverance:
 - Bondage to Satan
 - Freedom from sin
 - Healing from sickness
 - Overcoming addictions
 - Healing from hurts
 - Overcoming tragedy
 - Living with loss.
- Pray for the protection of our children & youth.
 - In our school systems
 - In their walk with God
- Pray for the protection of the church.
- Pray for the next generation of disciples.
- Pray for the salvation of family members, co-workers, and neighbors that do not know Jesus.
- Pray for the salvation of those who are deceived by false religions.

9:00-12:00 am: Prayer for Strength

Prayer Prompts

Joshua 1:5-9 • 2 Corinthians 12:6-10 • Ephesians 3:14-21

The second watch is a period of preparation to be strengthened in facing the battle that is to come.

- Where do you see a battle about to take place that you need to spiritually prepare for?
- Who do you see going through a battle that you can pray God's strength for them to face?
- Pray for those who are struggling in their marriages; in their parenting; in their faith; in their careers; etc.
- Pray for those who are struggling with ongoing sin.
- Pray for those who struggle with mental and emotional health issues.
- Pray for those who cannot pray for themselves.

12:00-3:00 am: Prayer for Perseverance

Prayer Prompts

Hebrews 10:32-39 • James 1:2-12 • Revelation 2:8-11

The third watch is a time to pray for perseverance to withstand the onslaught to your faith and mission from God. It is a period of spiritual battle in which the foundations of your faith will be tested.

- Where is the battle raging in your life?
- Where do you need to pray for perseverance?
- Who do you need to pray for?
- Pray endurance for those who are facing affliction, illness, and various trials.
- Pray for the congregation to persevere in seeking to grow in holiness and faith.
- Pray for the church to persevere through times of discouragement; waiting for God's direction; and in making disciples.

3:00-6:00 am: Prayer for Victory

Prayer Prompt

Romans 6:5-18 • 1 Corinthians 15:51-58 • Ephesians 6:10-18

It is in this final watch was of the night that victory comes to those who have persevered in the faith and trusted God. As the dawn breaks through the dark of night, so too does the power of God break through the forces of spiritual darkness.

- What are the breakthroughs you need in your life?
- Who can you pray victory for?
- Praise Jesus for His sacrifice which secured our salvation.
- Pray for ongoing victory over sins that continue to persist, even the subtle sins.
- Pray for victory in moving forward in God's will for Grace.
- Pray for victory that the Gospel would prevail in countries that are hostile toward Jesus.
