Since our first worship service on October 16, 1983, Peninsula has been a place where the Gospel is proclaimed, people grow in their knowledge of Jesus, and are equipped to share the Gospel with others.

From humble beginnings of just 45 faithful members building a church "in the middle of nowhere", we've grown into a thriving community. Today, more than 1,000 people gather on our campus each week for worship, right in the heart of one of the busiest areas of Mooresville.

The Pathway Project represents the next step in our journey as we pursue the mission God has given us: to make disciples who make disciples.

Our hope is that this book will help connect the vision, mission, and next steps needed to fulfill our calling. Each of us has a vital role to play in this next chapter—one that will impact generations to come.

What is The Pathway Project?

The Pathway Project is a two-year initiative designed to fund the mission and vision of Peninsula as we take intentional steps to expand, equip, and send. This initiative will allow us to:

- *Expand* our facility, beginning with a new worship center. Future phases will include additional classrooms for kids, preschool, and adults, along with expanded common gathering spaces to foster community.
- *Equip* our church family with greater capacity for discipleship through deeper engagement, helping each person grow into a disciple who makes disciples.
- Send more equipped disciples into our neighborhoods and to the nations, advancing the Gospel through missions, outreach, and future church plants.



We will take a phased approach to expansion.

Our first priority is constructing a new Worship Center that will double our seating capacity to 1100. This new building will be connected to the existing facility near the current worship center stage. Phase one will also include preparing the new lower level space for future classrooms and adding new parking.

In subsequent phases, we plan to complete new lower level classrooms and remodel the current worship center to include additional classrooms and a new common gathering area to better serve our growing church family.



WHY NOW?

What we build today will shape tomorrow.

Peninsula is growing rapidly - with an average growth rate of 19% over the past three years, our worship seating is quickly approaching capacity. As more families join our church, our preschool, kids, and youth ministries are expanding as well. We have been creative in maximizing our current building and classroom spaces, but we're quickly reaching our limits.

WHAT WILL EXPANDING ACCOMPLISH?

The new Worship Center is the key that unlocks space for all other ministries.

Expanding creates a domino effect. Once our church family can all gather in one worship space, a video venue is no longer needed. This allows the youth to return to the Youth Center, which in turn frees up The Loft to become additional classroom space.

WILL WE CONTINUE TWO SERVICE TIMES?

Yes, we will continue to offer two worship service times.

This rhythm is part of Peninsula's DNA and plays a vital role in our mission. It allows us to grow our Adult Connect Groups, one of the primary ways we equip our church family. It also allows families to worship together during one hour while attending age-appropriate classes separately during the other hour each Sunday.

In addition, having two services helps our children's ministries make efficient use of classroom space, supporting discipleship across every age and stage of life.





EQUIP AND SEND

The Pathway Project is more than a physical building project.

It's a Kingdom-building mission. It's about investing in the people of Peninsula and those God is bringing to us, so that we can faithfully live out our calling: to make disciples who make disciples. To equip simply means to prepare someone for a task. For followers of Christ, that task is clear - to share the Gospel and live it out daily.

At Peninsula, equipping happens in several intentional ways:

Sunday Morning Worship Services are designed to teach, encourage, and challenge believers to grow in their faith and pursuit of Christ.

Connect Groups are smaller communities where believers form meaningful relationships and engage in deeper conversations around Scripture. These groups are vital spaces for encouragement, accountability, and spiritual growth.

Discipleship Pathway is modeled after Jesus' relationship with His closest disciples. This initiative pairs one leader with three disciples. It's a focused, intimate setting for strengthening our foundation, growing in biblical confidence, and preparing each person to disciple others.

Bible Studies & Events are opportunities to help us dig into God's Word and draw closer to Christ. Our aim is to grow in our knowledge and affections for Christ so that our lives are shaped by Him.



FROM OUR NEIGHBORHOODS TO THE NATIONS

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Our mission is clear: to make disciples who make disciples - starting in our neighborhoods and extending to the nations.

Expanding for Mission Impact

This season of expansion isn't just about making space - it's about multiplying impact. More space means greater capacity to equip, and greater capacity to equip means greater capacity to send. For many of us, that means sharing the Gospel right where we are - with neighbors, coworkers, classmates, or friends. For others, it may mean helping plant a church, joining a new ministry effort, going on a short-term mission trip, or even stepping into international missions.

Whatever the call, we want to be a church that is ready and willing to respond - a people committed to fulfilling the Great Commission.









THE PATHWAY PROJECT GOALS



Goal #1: 100% Participation

As the body of Christ, every member has a vital role to play in this project. Reaching our goal will require a combination of substantial gifts, smaller gifts, and perhaps even lifestyle adjustments that allow each of us to practice greater generosity.

This project is not about equal giving, but equal participation - everyone working together in faith and unity toward making the vision a reality.

Goal #2: \$12M over the next two years

(Dec. 2025 - Dec. 2027)

At Peninsula, we use a "one fund" approach to giving. The \$12M goal includes \$6M for the annual operating budget and \$6M of expanded giving that would allow us to begin construction.



The Pathway Project Goals

CONSTRUCTION ESTIMATES

*The expansion will be accomplished in three phases.

Estimated cost of phase one is \$10.5M. This phase includes constructing a new Worship Center (approximately doubling our seating capacity), preparing the lower level space for future classrooms, and increasing parking by thirty percent with an improved traffic flow.

The building and finance committees are evaluating cost for future phases amid a shifting construction market with a current estimate of \$3.5M (totaling \$14M for the estimated cost for all three phases). Phases two and three include completing lower level classrooms and remodeling the current worship center for additional classrooms and gathering space.

The Pathway Project campaign will allow us to begin phase one of construction - the foundational step toward realizing the full vision. Each phase will be completed as funds become available and future campaigns will focus on eliminating any remaining debt.

We are committed to moving forward with wisdom, prayer, and faith - trusting God to provide as we invest in the mission of making disciples who make disciples.

HOW DOES A ONE FUND INITIATIVE WORK?

All gifts flow into one fund to support one mission.

First, the operating budget is funded. This ensures that all current ministries, staffing, and facility expenses continue without interruption.

• Our 2-year operating budget goal is \$6M.

The overflow or "expanded giving" will go toward funding the beginning of our expansion project.

• Our 2-year goal for expanded giving is \$6M, bringing the total goal for The Pathway Project 2-year initiative to \$12M.

For reference, the total giving (operating budget plus expanded giving) over the previous two-year period was \$5.9M.

WHAT WILL IT TAKE TO ACCOMPLISH THE GOAL?

A Journey of Generosity

Fulfilling the vision of The Pathway Project will require each of us to be challenged in our generosity. We must remember that in God's eyes, generosity is not just a financial transaction, it is a heart transformation.

We are all in different stages of the generosity journey.

Some may be giving for the first time.

Some give comfortably and consistently.

Others have learned the joy of giving sacrificially.

Wherever you are, we encourage you to pause, pray, and ask God how He is calling you to grow in this season. Stretching in generosity isn't about equal gifts - it's about equal sacrifice and faithful obedience.

Certainly, reaching our goal will require substantial gifts. It will also take many small and medium gifts - the kind that come from simple, intentional lifestyle changes. Whether it's giving up a \$6 coffee or forgoing a \$20,000 vacation, we move closer to the goal when we sacrifice something of value for something we value even more: the mission and vision God has given to Peninsula.

The Gift Guide is a Tool for the Generosity Journey


