From our Pastor...

Why Now? Because What We Build Today Shapes Tomorrow.

Peninsula is growing quickly. With a growth rate average of 19% over the last three years, our worship center seating will reach capacity within two years. But this moment isn't just about numbers; it is about faithfulness to the mission Jesus gave us - to make disciples who make disciples. The Pathway Project is our response. It is a bold, forward-looking step designed to prepare us for long-term gospel impact through three strategic outcomes.

First, we will expand our space for worship and create age-appropriate environments for our children's ministry. Families come through our doors each week, and we want to make room for every generation to grow in Christ and thrive in community.

Second, as we expand, we desire to continue equipping our church family to make disciples. This will include fully funding our operating budget for the ongoing ministries of Peninsula and launching new initiatives to provide additional pathways for discipleship. Whether someone is new to the faith or has walked with Christ for years, these pathways will provide opportunities for deeper spiritual growth and the encouragement needed to invest in others. It is about building a culture where disciple-making becomes a shared, life-giving rhythm.

Third, we are casting a vision to plant and strengthen churches. As Mooresville continues to grow, we must respond. We believe Peninsula is called to be a sending hub - to train and send leaders who will shape our region and beyond with biblical truth and a gospel-centered community.

We don't know when Christ will return, but if He tarries 100 years, our faithfulness now should still echo into that future. Our two-year goal is \$12M to include \$6M for our 2026 and 2027 operating budget and \$6M initial funding to begin expanding our facilities while we equip and send our church family. This is a two-year initiative that will impact generations to come. Let's be faithful now and build a legacy of making disciples that echoes into eternity.

HOW DOES A ONE FUND INITIATIVE WORK?

At Peninsula, we follow a One Fund approach to giving. All tithes and offerings go into a single fund, which first supports our general operating budget ensuring the day-to-day ministry and mission of the church are fully resourced. Anything given beyond those needs, the "overflow", is then used to fuel additional projects that extend our impact.

The Pathway Project will be our primary initiative funded during the next two-years. This project includes the 2026 and 2027 operating budgets, as well as the expansion of our worship and children's facilities, creating more space for connection, discipleship, and sending. It's not just about brick and mortar, it's about a pathway to make disciples who make disciples. We're making room for the next steps God is calling us to take together.
