Simple. Six letters which, when placed together in a particular order, are meant to mean "easy to understand or do; not difficult." Yet, for many, especially Christians attending and serving in the local church, this word is oxymoronic, because even when we say something is simple, it is inevitably not. God has provided us a simple plan, "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you" (Matt. 28:19-20a), but we have complicated it. In the upcoming year, through much prayer, planning, great effort, partnership, and kingdommindedness, it is my hope and vision

that we will "get back to the basics" and be the simple church that we are called to be.

This will start with a very simple, four-step discipleship plan that I am calling, "Connect Four." Through it we will seek to (1) Connect People to God, (2) Connect People to One Another, (3) Connect People to Our Community, and (4) Connect People to the Lost. Each of these steps will correspond to worship service attendance, Sunday School and small group ministries, service opportunities, and intentional evangelism. The overall goal of this simple, stream-lined discipleship plan is to both mature in our faith through relationship

with God and others, and to grow as a church body, too. I firmly believe that if we, as a church, will undertake this plan together and make it the foundation and "life-blood" of who we are, we will see many great benefits, both as individuals, and also through the work of the Holy Spirit in our church. So, I am asking you to begin to pray about this and to be open to the propositions that are made in the future, so that we can be the simple, biblical, mature, soul-winning church that we are called to be!
