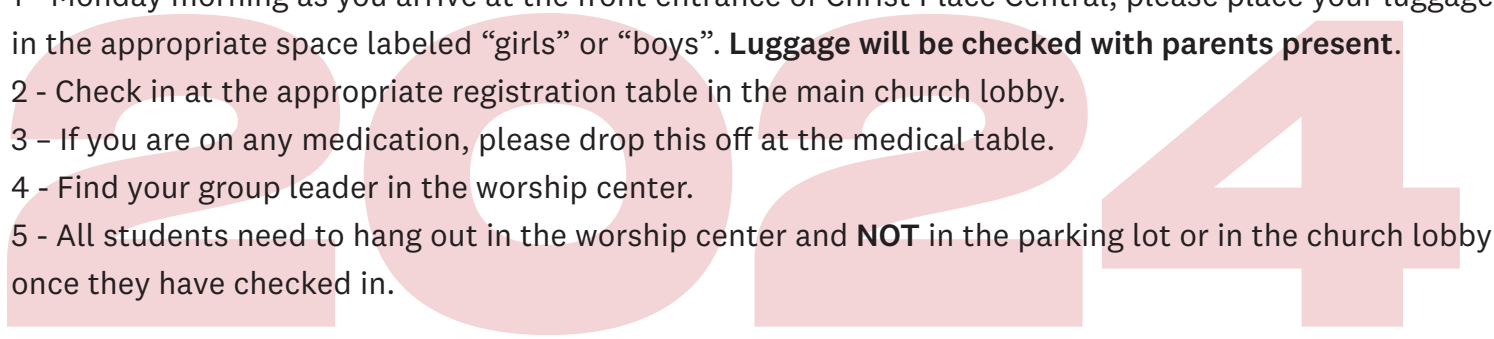

MONDAY MORNING CHECKLIST

- 1 - Monday morning as you arrive at the front entrance of Christ Place Central, please place your luggage in the appropriate space labeled “girls” or “boys”. **Luggage will be checked with parents present.**
- 2 - Check in at the appropriate registration table in the main church lobby.
- 3 - If you are on any medication, please drop this off at the medical table.
- 4 - Find your group leader in the worship center.
- 5 - All students need to hang out in the worship center and **NOT** in the parking lot or in the church lobby once they have checked in.



DEPARTURE SCHEDULE (MAY 27)

- Check in will begin at 6:30am – doors will NOT be opened earlier than this
- Load the Buses at 8:00am (Any student that is not at church by 8:00am for check-in will be considered as not going to camp. (Refunds for these students will not be available).
- Once bus captains conduct a head count and give the student team the “okay” we begin Student Camp 2024!!!
- Arrive at camp around 12:00pm.

PICKUP SCHEDULE (MAY 31)

- Please pick up students promptly at 1:00pm at the North Entrance of Christ Place Central.

SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION NOTE

If your student is not riding with us to camp, but will be brought there by you, please confirm your plans with the camp team (camp@christplace.com), so we know not to wait for your student on the morning that we leave for camp.

If your student is being picked up at camp and will not be riding back with us to the church, please confirm your plans with the camp team (camp@christplace.com) so that we know when they are leaving and with whom they are leaving.

I. GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Guys and girls will not sit with each other during the bus trip.
- Everyone is expected to attend all meetings. This means that everyone should be doing what everyone else is doing. The scheduled activities are not optional.
- When it's time for lights out, it means that all students should be in their rooms and it's time for lights to be out.
- No guys in girl's dorms. No girls in guy's dorms.
- During the Land and Lake Rec times, you must follow the Facility Safety Rules.
- Phones are not allowed at student camp. If your student brings their phone, their small group leader reserves the right to confiscate it until the end of the week.
- Be aware that you are personally responsible for damages to facilities.
- If you are sick and cannot go to recreation time, you need to have an adult leader accompany you to see the medical staff.
- No practical jokes, pranks, or bullying will be tolerated. These will result in your student being sent home immediately at the expense of the parent. **This is a zero-tolerance policy.**
- No sneaking out of your room during the night. Attempting to do so will result in your student being sent home immediately at the expense of the parent. **This is a zero-tolerance policy.**
- You must stay with your small group leader at all times. (Exception times and designated areas will be explained once we arrive at camp.)
- Christ Place Church and Adventure Ocoee reserve the right to search any room at any time.
- Do not leave the camp.
- Do not go hiking.
- Respect all student staff and leaders. If they ask you to do something, do it.
- Be respectful of other people.
- **Have a great, Christ-like attitude with no whining.**

2. BEHAVIOR

- No PDA (Public Display of Affection) - including holding hands.
- You do NOT need to begin or end a relationship during camp.
- No Special Relationships! Treat everyone equally with Christ-like love.

3. DRESS

- Dress appropriately for all worship services. (No athletic clothes).
- Girls: One-piece bathing suits or tankinis (NO TUMMY SHOWING AT ALL!!!).
- Guys: No swimsuits that are too big revealing underwear or too short.
- Bathing suits may be worn at land recreation but must be covered at all times with shorts and shirt-GIRLS and GUYS must wear a shirt.
- When walking to and from the pool or lake, you **MUST** wear your shirt and cover-up.
- NO short shorts. Students are not allowed to roll shorts up to make them shorter. They **MUST** be fingertip length or longer.
- If an adult decides your clothing is inappropriate you will be asked to change. Do so respectfully and without complaining.
- NO spaghetti/thin strapped tank tops unless a shirt is worn overtop/underneath. Shirts that expose any torso are not allowed.

4. WHAT NOT TO BRING

- **NO ELECTRONICS** (i.e. cell phones, video games (Nintendo Switch, etc.), or iPods)
- No tobacco products, drugs, alcohol, weapons, fireworks, lighters, matches, secular magazines, silly string. These items will be taken from you if brought on the bus or to camp. We want our focus to be on Jesus and have no distractions.
