JANUARY - JUNE

Hello, Hope Church family. I'm sharing the first six months of our 2026 Bible Reading Plan; the remaining reading suggestions will be sent by June.

My goal for us this year is not just to read the Bible but to study it. We are launching Hope Groups this year. This endeavor is deeply biblical, and we see the benefits of small groups unfold as we read through the Gospels and the Book of Acts.

I'm requesting that we study the books of Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, Acts, and finally the book of Proverbs. As you study the Gospels, pay close attention to the works and words of Jesus. Look closely at the responses of those He taught and observe how the Disciples respond to His teachings. As you read the Book of Acts, pay attention to how the Disciples of Jesus carried out what they learned while Jesus was on the earth. We're reading Proverbs because we need God's wisdom to accomplish all that the Lord has for us.

The Lord has called you and me to finish His work. To do so, we must follow the methods and examples given to us in the Word of the Lord.

My challenge again is not just to read the Bible but to study it and allow the Lord to speak to us as we do so.
