

ATTITUDE OF GRATITUDE

Annette and Joseph Hearn

For Annette and Joseph Hearn, life has been a cross-continental journey of faith, service, and high-stakes responsibility. Annette’s story began in the city of eternal spring, Medellín, Colombia, where her father served as an SDA pastor and college dean and her mother as a school teacher. In 1959, the family moved to Miami. There, her father sold goods door-to-door while Annette and her sister, Mavis, sang in churches. Eventually, they settled in Los Angeles, where her father pastored the San Fernando Spanish SDA Church for ten years. After graduating from SFV Academy, Annette followed a calling to nursing, graduating from Loma Linda University in 1975 to work in the intense world of ICU and trauma.

Joseph’s background was equally cinematic. His father was a legendary Lockheed test pilot—one of the first to fly the P-38 Lightning. His mother, born in Colombia, was the daughter of a German-Jewish diplomat who refused Hitler’s order to return to Germany. Instead, the family moved to Pasadena, California, where Joseph was born. While Joseph was still a baby, the family moved back to Colombia, where he attended a strict Catholic military boarding school from age eight. As a Protestant, he had to obtain special permission from a priest to read the Bible his grandmother had given him. Joseph returned to the U.S. when he was sixteen, was drafted into the military, and served four years in Vietnam. He later continued his education, eventually retiring from the military in 1987 before joining the U.S. Marshal Service.

Their worlds collided in 1982 at Hollywood Medical Center. Joseph was guarding an arrested money launderer who had faked a heart attack. Annette, the nurse on duty, was taken aback by his intensity. However, when they discovered their shared Colombian heritage, the tensions melted. Annette was still cautious about his non-Adventist involvement, even giving him a fake phone number, but eventually invited him to church. Joseph, with his Colombian accent, was a complete hit with Annette’s family. Several months later, Joseph began Bible studies and developed a deep respect for Adventism. In 1984, Annette’s father, Dr. Augusto Britton, officiated their wedding. Soon thereafter, Joseph was baptized and found his spiritual home in the SDA church.

Parenthood became their greatest shared trial. For ten long years and through the heartbreak of nine lost pregnancies, Annette prayed Hannah’s prayer. The silence finally broke in 1993 with the birth of Joseph Alexander—a miracle baby who required a thirteen-week hospital stay to survive. Their second son, James, followed in 1997. Both were dedicated to God before they were born, attended Adventist schools, and graduated from Andrews University.

Annette’s career grew into forty years of senior leadership in occupational health, managing safety for corporate giants in heavy industry and aerospace. Today she continues to manage medical surveillance as a Public Health Nurse for Aerojet Rocketdyne. Joseph continued his long life of service to veterans and the State of California, including CalVet and FEMA, until his retirement in 2007. In 2009, after the death of Dr. Britton, the family joined Vallejo Drive Church.

Through the years, Joseph has been serving as a deacon and on the safety committee, while Annette has been an Elder and poured her passion into children’s, parenting, and music ministries. Their growing family remains a clear answer to prayer. Joseph-Alexander, a commercial pilot married to Aimee, a DVM, has gifted them a grandson, Mateo Samuel. James-Andrew is a music educator and worship leader at Grace Hill.

"We are aware how similar we are, no matter where we come from," Annette says. For the marshal and the nurse, life has come full circle—from Colombia to Grace Hill—proving that whether guarding a prisoner or a patient, God’s timing is impeccable and His grace unfathomable.

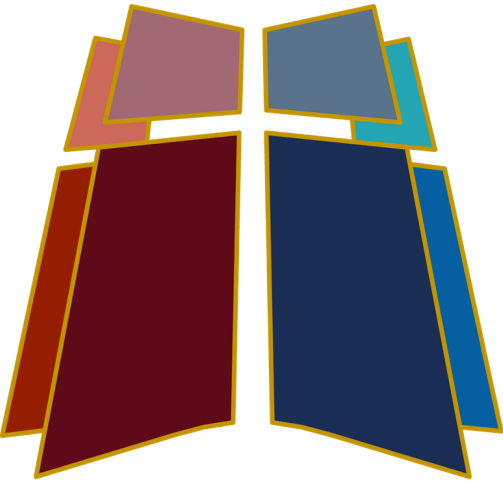
