

ATTITUDE OF GRATITUDE



Roland and Joana Tamayo
Joana was born in 1975 in Manila, Philippines, to a nurse and a physician. Three years later, her mother was invited to work at the Glendale Adventist Medical Center (GAMC), and the family moved to the United States. However, her father struggled to get certified to practice medicine in the U.S. Just as the family prepared to return to the Philippines, he received an offer to repeat his residency at USC to become an anesthesiologist.

Roland also has Filipino roots, although he was born in 1973 in Los Angeles. His parents had moved to the U.S. four years earlier. Roland’s mother worked as a nurse, but his father also was facing difficulties getting licensed to practice dentistry in the U.S. He initially worked as a janitor, but by the time Roland was born, he had passed the board exam and opened his own dental practice. The family soon moved to Glendale.

Both Joana and Roland attended Glendale Adventist Academy. Though they were in different grades, they connected at GAA. They both sang in the chorale and were in the same Spanish class. Joana became Roland’s confidant and a good listener. This acquaintance evolved into a 12-year relationship.

Joana always knew she wanted to be a physician. She attended Loma Linda University Medical School and did her residency at White Memorial Medical Center. Since 2005 Joana has worked as an OB/GYN at GAMC and other hospitals, delivering countless babies, some of whom are now members of the Vallejo Drive Church.

As the only son, Roland felt obligated to take over his father's dental practice. He initially pursued a pre-dental program, but felt it wasn’t the right path for him. His older sister relieved his anxiety by offering to take over their father's practice. Roland was then free to pursue his passion for art. He enrolled at the Art Center in Pasadena and graduated in 1999 with a Bachelor of Fine Arts in illustration. His career has since taken him into the video game industry and art gallery shows.

Joana and Roland married in 2003 at Vallejo Drive Church. Five years later, they welcomed fraternal twin boys, Bradley and Tyler. However, a challenge arose when Tyler was diagnosed with severe myopia, nystagmus, and strabismus, and doctors could not predict how this would affect Tyler’s development, learning, and driving. The family was devastated but prayed earnestly for him.

Initially, Tyler attended a public school that provided an Individualized Education Program (IEP) for his eye condition, but when his condition improved in the 3rd grade, he transferred to GAA. Both boys thrived there. As people continued praying and Tyler developed coping mechanisms, he kept improving. He excelled in his studies, was accepted into the NHS, and is now working toward his driver’s license. Tyler dreams of becoming a professional pianist like his piano teacher and mentor Matt Daley. Bradley, a talented drummer, hopes to become a fashion designer.

The Tamayo family has a long history with the Vallejo Drive Church, which they have always considered their home. Now that their sons are older, they feel it is time to become more involved in the church, community service, and missionary work. Joana is closing her OB/GYN practice to work part-time, allowing her more time to accomplish their new goals. The Tamayos are encouraged by the direction the church is taking, as it is growing stronger and friendlier, and is a place where they can reconnect with old friends and meet new people. They are grateful to be a part of a growing church that is developing a servant's heart.
