## ATTITUDE OF GRATITUDE

#### Rudy and Noemi Umali

Rudy (Rodrigo) and Noemi Umali are treasured, long-term members who have been a vital part of the Vallejo Drive Church family for close to 45 years. They transferred their membership from the Philippines in 1981, soon after arriving in the United States. Both hail from devoted Seventh-day Adventist families and were born on Luzon—Noemi in Biñan, Laguna, and Rudy in Lipa, about 30 miles apart. They both were baptized around the age of 10.



They both chose to study at Philippine Union College (now Adventist University of the Philippines). Though attending at different times, their shared commitment to Christian service determined their academic choices. Noemi earned a BS in Education to become an elementary teacher, while Rudy pursued a BS in Business Administration, preparing him for roles of financial stewardship.

Noemi dedicated two decades of her life to education, teaching elementary students, primarily in Adventist schools. Meanwhile, Rudy focused on financial ministry, serving in the South Central Luzon Mission (now Conference). He held several critical roles, including accountant, Assistant Treasurer, and Auditor at the Mission Headquarters in San Pablo City, before serving as Treasurer at the Lipa Adventist Academy.

Their paths first crossed in Lipa under unconventional circumstances. Noemi was teaching in a local school and boarding with a doctor's family at a small Adventist clinic. Rudy, before going to PUC, was humbly working as the clinic's ianitor.

Rudy was immediately captivated by the kind and beautiful teacher. Despite the vast difference in their social standing—a janitor pursuing a respected teacher—Rudy's heart was instantly set on her. His determination was absolute. He persistently tried to win her affection, showering her with attention and writing heartfelt letters that consistently went unanswered. Noemi initially showed clear disinterest. When he was invited to a meal, she famously burned his pancakes, and she returned the chocolates he gave her, stating, "I don't eat chocolate."

Despite the clear rejection, Rudy was not deterred, seeing her initial resistance as a challenge rather than a final verdict. His effort continued for nearly five years, even as Noemi was being pursued by another young man. Rudy also had powerful allies in his corner: the doctor's family, who greatly admired his character and viewed him as their own son, and the mission president, a friend who believed the couple belonged together. The doctor's wife explicitly told Noemi, "I would hate for him to marry someone else."

Noemi finally recognized Rudy's admirable character traits, especially his quiet persistence, endurance, and deep commitment against all odds. She began to see him as a viable marriage partner. They dated for about a year and were married in December 1971 and were blessed with three lovely children: Minette, William, and Rodrigo, Jr.

In 1980 the Umalis decided to emigrate to the US. They settled in Glendale, quickly finding a home in the Southern California Adventist community. Rudy secured an accountant position at Glendale Adventist Hospital for 20 years, followed by 10 years as a senior accountant for White Memorial Hospital. Parallel to Rudy, Noemi served in Nutrition Services at Glendale Adventist Hospital for over 25 years. They both retired in 2010 after decades of dedicated service.

The Umalis are an integral and cherished part of our Grace on the Hill at Vallejo Drive Church family. This has been their spiritual home for the last 45 years, where their children grew up, were nurtured, and served alongside them. Rudy and Noemi have served faithfully in various capacities, embodying the spirit of community and dedication. We thank God for this beautiful family.
