TO RENAME OR NOT TO RENAME

This Sabbath our church faces the beginning of a significant vote: to rename our church. Members will cast ballots today, August 9, after the service, and voting will remain open until next Sabbath, August 16. This decision will cap a year-long period of reflection, conversation, and weighing pros and cons. Our church first opened its doors in 1924 as the **Glendale Sanitarium Seventh-day Adventist Church**, affectionately known as "The San." Forty years later, upon moving into our new sanctuary across the street, we renamed the church after its street location. For the past 60 years, we've been known as the **Vallejo Drive Church of Seventh-day Adventists**.

Over two decades ago, a powerful revival of God's grace swept through our congregation. We considered various ways to reflect this crucial emphasis, including rebranding the church. Although the time wasn't right for a name change then, our commitment to grace was boldly reflected in other ways. Our website adopted a new URL,

Today, 25 years later, are we ready for a rebrand that clearly reflects our purpose? Given our emphasis on grace and our church's literal location on a hill, the pastors and Board of the church put forth the name **Grace Hill Seventh-day Adventist Church** as a possible replacement. We considered this name for its profound spiritual significance. "Grace Hill" points us back to Calvary, where Jesus sacrificed His life for the world. It also reminds us to be the church "on the hill that cannot be hidden" (Matthew 5:14), a place where people experience genuine grace through worship, teaching, and acts of service.

Let's be clear: changing our name does not alter our identity or mission as a Seventh-day Adventist church. Our Bible-centered preaching will remain steadfast while we align our name more closely with our spiritual focus.

We currently face a name recognition issue. Vallejo, a Spanish surname, means nothing to most people today. Our community survey revealed frequent confusion; as we often had to repeat the name multiple times, hearing responses like, "Did you say Valley?" or "Is that Valero, like the gas station?"

Some have asked, "Why can't we keep our current name, still be a place of unconditional grace, and just be more active in the community so we're better known?" Well, we already are a place of grace, and are active in the community-- Laundry Love, Home Again L.A., food bank, exercise classes-- and people are still struggling to know who we are. It's challenging to recall a name when it is not memorable and is difficult to pronounce. We simply aim to make ministry easier.

Finally, a name that transcends a local street communicates more effectively, resonating both locally and globally. When our mission teams wear t-shirts with our church's name and logo, they should perfectly align with our beliefs, purpose, passion, and mission. Even God named His Son, Jesus (God saves), in line with His mission, in order to reach and touch the people He came to save.

With that said, we'll simplify what we're voting on today and this week. Maybe you're open to change, but not in favor of the name the board selected. So we'll simply vote on if the membership is open to a name change or not. Choosing a church name is an important decision because it shapes identity, reflects mission, and can impact how the community perceives the church. In making your decision, we'd like you to consider six key criteria to consider when selecting a name:

- 1. Theological Accuracy: Does the name reflect our church's doctrine and beliefs?
- 2. Mission and Vision Alignment: Does the name align with our church's purpose and outreach goals?
- 3. Cultural and Community Relevance: Is the name understandable, relatable, and inviting to our local context, especially to the unchurched?
- 4. Uniqueness, Clarity and Memorability: Is the name already widely used and/or something easy to pronounce, spell, and remember?
- 5. Longevity and Scalability: Will the name still fit 40 years from now as our church grows?
- 6. Legacy: Does the name speak to the legacy and history of the church?

Finally, we want to assure you that regardless of the outcome of our vote, together we are and will be more than motivated to do ministry with commitment, passion, and grace.
