<u>Highlight - Sermon on the Mount & At Home Discussion Questions</u>

We are one month into our Sunday night study through the Sermon on the Mount. In the past few weeks, we've talked about how Jesus calls his disciples to a greater righteousness than that of the Pharisees. While the Pharisees displayed a hollow religion—focused on outward appearances without true heart transformation—Jesus calls his disciples to a whole-person righteousness that starts in the heart and flows outward.

Sermon on the Mount - Week 5 (Matthew 5:33-48)

1. What does this passage have to say about keeping your word? Why do you think being truthful matters?

- 2. The world often says, "get even" when someone hurts us. How is Jesus's way of responding different?
- 3. Is there someone you're finding hard to love right now? How might remembering how Jesus loved change the way we treat that person?

Sermon on the Mount - Week 6 (Matthew 6:1-18)

- 1. Jesus warns against doing "good things" just to be noticed. What might that look like today?
- 2. When Jesus teaches about prayer (verses 5-15), what's one thing that really stands out to you?
- 3. Thinking about Jesus's teaching on prayer, is there anything you'd like to do differently when you pray?

Sermon on the Mount - Week 7 (Matthew 6:19-34)

- 1. Jesus says not to store up treasures on earth. What do you think he means by that? How could it shape what we want or work for?
- 2. In verses 22-23, Jesus talks about our eyes. Why do you think what we watch and focus on is so important?
- 3. In verses 25-34, Jesus talks about worry. What part of his teaching about anxiousness do you find most helpful or encouraging?
