# Sermon on the Mount - Week 1 (Matthew 5:1-12)

- 1. How should we understand the word "blessed" in the Beatitudes?
- 2. Which Beatitude stands out to you the most? Why?
- 3. What should we fix our minds on when facing persecution for following Jesus?

## Sermon on the Mount - Week 2 (Matthew 5:13-16)

- 1. Why does Jesus use the images of salt and light?
- 2. In what ways will Christians look different from the world?
- 3. When are you tempted to shrink back and blend in with the world?

## Sermon on the Mount - Week 3 (Matthew 5:17-20)

- 1. What does this passage teach us about the Old Testament?
- 2. How does a disciple of Jesus have a different type of righteousness than the Pharisees?
- 3. Why is it important to remember that God sees not only our outward actions but also our inward heart?

#### Sermon on the Mount - Week 4 (Matthew 5:21-32)

- 1. What does Jesus teach about anger in this passage?
- 2. Is there someone in your life you've treated unkindly or need to forgive?
- 3. How are adultery, lust, and divorce described here? What warnings does Jesus give?




#### **Recommended Resources of the Month**
