But God has so composed the body, giving greater honor to the part that lacked it, ²⁵ that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another. ²⁶ If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together.

should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," that would not make it any less a part of the body. ¹⁶ And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body," that would not make it any less a part of the body. ¹⁷ If the whole body were an eye, where would be the sense of hearing? If the whole body were an ear, where would be the sense of smell? ¹⁸ But as it is, God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as he chose. ¹⁹ If all were a single member, where would the body be? ²⁰ As it is, there are many parts, yet one body.

Our MEDIA TEAM makes the **MOST IMPACT** when:

- We communicate from clearly, putting an emphasis on readability and legibility.
- We create art as worship. Striving for excellence that even non-church folks can admire and relate to while never usurping the gospel to cater to culture
- We take our craft seriously, putting in time on our own to hone our talents so they are at a high standard
- We expect revisions to refine our work and end up with a better 'product' at the end of a project

MEDIA TEAM DEPARTMENTS

The Media Team serves on a regular basis covering weekend services, as well as other ministry events such as Student Ministry and Redemption & Recovery to have a constant drip of great photos and clips displaying church life here at emergence to keep our screens, print collateral, website and socials looking great and up to date.

PHOTO

- Cover Emergence services and events (weekend services, other ministry events)
- Edit photos, organize and catalog for web, social, and print

VIDEO

- Film and edit events as well as high-level pieces that document certain ministry values or vision (eNews, Ministry highlights, high production value update videos)
- Edit videos/clips, organize and catalog for web, social, and print

SOCIAL

- Manage our website and social media outlets
- Seek new ways to improve our digital facing look and feel

WHAT YOU NEED TO SUCCEED

TO GET READY TO SERVE EFFECTIVELY, YOU WILL NEED:

A GREAT ATTITUDE

- Creative work is hard. The workload is heavy, and oftentimes because of our weekly schedule the turnaround time is often quicker than you'd like.
- Good, honest work require critique and being able to handle healthy critique is an important part of having a good attitude. Expect there to be feedback, critique and revisions. If something can be communicating more casually, more clearly, or more concisely let's do it!
- Giving critique in a healthy way that produces better work while still valuing a person's work and their time is the most important skill we can have on the Media team.

GEAR

- The MEDIA TEAM is a great place to learn new skills or hone ones that you already have but in order to succeed you need to be invested in your own talents.
- That means if you want to be on the team your should have a high quality camera, smart phone equal or equivalent to the iPhone 14 (exceptions can be made), and a means to edit, organize and share files. You are not expected to own everything you will need, but you need to have the basics and know how to use them.



GETTING STARTED

Now that you know how we best make *IMPACT* together for Jesus, and you understand the tools we use to accomplish that work, it's time to get you plugged in and ready to serve!

These are the steps you need to take to get started on the MEDIA Team at Emergence:

CREATE AN ACCOUNT ON EMERGENCE CONNECT AT EMERGENCE.CHURCH/LOGIN

Emergence Connect is the system we use to communicate as a church. It's how we contact you for everything from input and feedback to registering for events, ministries, and other functions at church.

GET A PLANNING CENTER INVITE

Planning Center is where we schedule band, tech, and media. Once you're on board you'll set up a planning center profile to begin to get scheduled for services and events that need coverage.

WELCOME TO THE MEDIA TEAM!

Once you are ready to commit to serving on the team, you'll be added to the MEDIA Team group on Connect, and you'll be added in the rotation for future serving opportunities!

There you'll also have access to shot lists, training resources, and opportunities to grow in your craft.

A DAY IN THE LIFE

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

- You are photographers. Come prepared! Whether you are a mobile phone photographer, or using a camera, come with your gear charged and ready to go. (Don't forget you SD cards, or make space on your phone to capture the day!)
- Wear a black shirt and black pants of your own or the Creative Team shirts we have for you. (for real though, this really matters you'll be less of a distraction and look like your supposed to be walking around during service if you blend in by wearing black.)

WHEN YOU GET THERE

- Grab your IMPACT Lanyard (Also a great spot to put your shot list!)
- Arrive early to attend rehearsals, IMPACT Huddle and Pre-service rundown to be in the know and plan your approach (also a great time to get some shots you won't be able to get during service like on the stage and of things like set up)
- Cull as you go! Don't submit a folder of 500 photos... Only submit your top 20-50 shots/video clips. (Refer to your shot list for guidance on this)

BEFORE YOU LEAVE

- Have a plan for content delivery- drop box, we transfer, air drop etc.
- Be super timely with delivery, often we need to post a highlight of some kind either day of or within the week.

IN CLOSING

Jesus has impacted your life, and you're considering a step to allow Him to impact others through you. That's to be celebrated, and we're grateful He is at work!
