### How parents can help at home:

- Help your child find a place to keep handbook so they can find it easily on AWANA night.
- Encourage child to wear uniform and wear shoes for running during game time. No flip flops, avoid hard boots.

### Optional, but helpful parental support

- Spend time at home reading and reviewing handbook material. Just a little time can make a difference in memorization.
- Familiarize yourself with the handbook. Some sections require more time and home-related tasks.
- T&T/Sparks: When you help your child with memory verses, initial next to leader signature line and your child will receive extra AWANA bucks.
- Remind them to spend 5 or 10 minutes each day on verses. If they do this, most can finish a book in one AWANA calendar year.
