A Mission That Lasts: How One Church is Transforming Generations

At Legacy Imperative, we believe that grandparents and older generations have a powerful role to play in shaping the faith of the next generation. But passing on a spiritual legacy doesn't happen by accident—it takes intentionality, training, and community. That's why we don't do "one-and-done" events. Our mission is to equip older adults to disciple their families through a 3-step process: The NEXT GEN Summit, Mission Training, and Sustaining Groups.

For Dr. Ken Haller, this mission became personal after hearing about Legacy Imperative from his longtime friend, Dr. Bob. He saw the NEXT GEN Summit as a perfect fit for his church, Westminster Church in Muncie, Indiana, where many in the congregation are grandparents longing to see their families grow in faith.

"My desire was to carry on a legacy across the generations and see how Jesus Christ works in people's families," Dr. Haller shared.

In October 2023, 40 people attended the Summit—but the impact didn't stop there. Nearly half of them continued into Mission Training Groups, where they became Certified Missionaries to their grandchildren. Many then joined Sustaining Groups, where they pray, share discipleship successes and struggles, and develop ongoing skills to keep the momentum going.

Dr. Bob calls Westminster's training groups the "Gold Standard" of Legacy's mission. But according to Dr. Haller, there's no secret formula:

"It requires having a passion for it and being willing to put in the time.

The reward? Seeing how others are encouraged and blessed."


