

Reach Weekend FAQ

- What will Reach Weekend look like for my student?

This event will take place on Friday evening, all day Saturday, and Sunday morning. On Friday night after students check in, we will have a worship session that includes worship, games and a speaker. After each session they will have family group time, which will function as their life group for the weekend. We will finish off the night with silent disco before parents come for pick up!

On Saturday, we will start the morning off with session 2, then family groups followed by lunch. After lunch we will have breakouts, games, and an activity until dinner, then session 2. We will close out the night with family groups. On Sunday, we will have normal life groups with a big breakfast for our students and leaders and celebrate the end of Reach Weekend in the second service!

We will have a more detailed schedule available closer to the event.

- What is included in the price for the weekend?

The price of the event includes all programming, a Reach Weekend shirt, lunch and dinner on Saturday, breakfast on Sunday morning and snacks/beverages while on campus.

- What if my student is brand new to the ministry?

This is the best kind of student! We believe that Reach Weekend is the best place to start in the life of our ministry. This is his/her chance to spend the entire weekend with his/her grade/gender specific life group and connect in a way that we pray goes past the weekend!

- Can I sign up my student if he/she can only go for some of the weekend?

*YES! We have a handful of students who can only make a portion of the weekend. Our only request is that your student fill a **time away form** if he/she will be leaving the campus at any time. Please do not let a game or a prior appointment in town prevent your student from attending what he/she can!*

- Is it overnight?

Reach Weekend is not an overnight event. We love to see our parents organize their own host home, but we do not organize anything off campus for this event.

- If my child brings a friend, will they be together?

If your student brings a friend of the same gender and is in the same ministry (HS or MS), then we will work to make sure they are in the same group! Regardless of the group they are in, they will be around each other the whole weekend with the other students.

- Is there any paperwork that needs to be filled out?
