Pagan Threat: Confronting America's Godless Uprising

Depending on who you talk to these days, America is on the verge of being overtaken by AI (artificial intelligence) which in the view of even more (again, depending on who you talk to) will soon usher in the Antichrist, Worship of the Beast, bringing swift destruction to the entire globe. It's a carnival shooting gallery of opinion, reaction, over-reaction, and the integrity of some of this "information" would be better suited to a literary remake of Sinclair Lewis' epic 1927 novel, "Elmer Gantry." On the other hand, there are reasonable voices today sounding fact-based alarms and observation to the those who have ears to listen, that things in the spiritual world are not everything they should be. "Pagan Threat: Confronting American's Godless Uprising," by Lucas Miles, is one such message. Not that the threat is anything new. This pseudo-spiritual expression has been making inroads into culture for decades. So, don't blame Oprah Winfrey for it. This one's not all her fault.

Part of the blame may be the Church's failure to recognize signs of the times, subtle and not so subtle messages, and the people bringing them to the fore.

That's where this timely book comes into focus. Not everyone is going to read and agree with 100% on every page, but there is a wealth of material here to ponder and pray about as we see our culture grow darker. "To navigate this challenging era," writes Miles in the introduction to this compelling and urgent work, "Christians must renew their commitment to biblical truth while engaging the culture with grace and conviction, " pg. xiii, Introduction).

Agreed. And this book is a good place to begin understanding what's going on in today's world. This is a well-researched, balanced view of the Pagan culture of the 21st Century. It might be the first book you read to familiarize yourself with this trend but rest assured it will be an eye-opener and a platform for continued, thoughtful conversation and Bible study.
