#### WHY WE COVENANT

## **Reaffirms Our Identity In The Gospel**

Through the Gospel, God has already given us a new identity of being True Worshippers, Growing Disciples, Everyday Missionaries, and a Faith Family. As Jesus' body, we want to be serious about how we live this out, so that we, and Mayfield/Graves County would experience His awesome presence and power.

A "Covenant" is the deepest form of an agreement between two parties and is a very significant theme throughout the Bible. This theme reaches its pinnacle in the New Testament with a new covenant that allows us to enter a relationship with God through Jesus Christ. (Matthew 26:26-29) This new covenant offers us new desires, a new heart, a new identity, and new power, through God's Holy Spirit, to live an entirely new life! In light of this new covenant, and as a response to it, we are making this agreement together as a Faith Family to live out this new life *TOGETHER*.

#### **Clarifies What It Means To Follow Jesus**

Jesus encouraged His potential followers to "count the cost" of following Him (Luke 14:25-33). This Faith Family Covenant helps us to create a common understanding of the basics of what it means to follow Jesus and serves as a tool for reflection and growth in our pursuit of holiness.

If you profess to be a Christian, but don't live a changed life, you should take no comfort in your faith. John says, "This is how we are sure that we have come to know Him; by keeping His commands" (1 John 2:3). In short, how we live matters.

This covenant does not include every explicit command regarding obedience, but it does give a general summary of what it means to live as a Follower of Jesus.

## **Provides Accountability**

The church is called to live and act differently. In agreeing to this Faith Family Covenant, one is agreeing to be held accountable by a body of believers pursuing the same goal. In the same token, one is also agreeing to hold others accountable within this Faith Family. To hold accountable simply means to "take responsibility for," meaning that we are watching out for the interests of others as well. Any church covenant, void of this responsibility, is a worthless document. Scripture demonstrates our need for accountability over and over again (Matthew 18:15-17 / 1 Corinthians 5).
