# **EXODUS Chapters 31-32**

## **Opening Questions:**

- a. If God were to gift you with one extraordinary skill or talent to use for His purposes, what would you want it to be, and why?
- b. How long would you wait for something/someone before you do something different?
- c. If you had to design a funny or unusual statue to represent God today, what would it look like?
- d. If you were a pastor and your congregation asked for something silly (like a popcorn machine in the sanctuary), what's one thing you might actually say yes to?"

#### **Discussion Questions:**

### **Chapter 31: Giftings, Sabbath**

- 1. What is the ancestry of Bezaleel?
- 2. How would you summarize his giftings? What made him qualified?
- 3. Could Bezaleel have done the work without God?
- 4. Why does God often appoint people to work together rather than alone? (*Ecc. 4:9–10; Mark 6:7; 1 Corinthians 3:6–9*)
- 5. Is there a difference between Bezalel and Oholiab's roles? (*Genesis 49:8, 16*)
- 6. How does the Holy Spirit empower artisans and workers?
- 7. Why do you think God reminded the Israelites to keep his Sabbath at this time?

- 8. Why does God attach such severe consequences to dishonoring the Sabbath? Does that help you alter your thinking on how New Testament believers should view the Sabbath? (Numbers 15:32–36; Isaiah 58:13–14; James 2:10).
- 9. Verse 18 states that the Lord stopped speaking to Moses and gave him the tablets. Why do you think he ended here? (see Exodus 20)

#### **Chapter 32:1-6**

- 10. From the Israelite POV, what did Mt. Sinai look like while Moses was there? (Ex. 19-16-18, 24:15-17)
- 11. How long was Moses gone from the camp? Would you consider this time a "delay?"
- 12. Provide some reasons why the Israelites requested that Aaron "make us gods."
- 13. How did Aaron respond? Discuss what motivated him and if any other options were available to respond to the people.
- 14. Who decided on making a calf? (verse4). Was it arbitrary?
- 15. Recall the backgrounds of Moses and Aaron. Is there any irony in their respective positions at this point?
- 16. Did the Israelites completely abandon worship of the true God with this act? What about Aaron? Explain your answer. (Exodus 20:1-17)
- 17. What Commandments are violated in verses 1-6? Is one more egregious?
- 18. How did the idol worship progress into other sins?
