## **Opening Questions:**

- a. Name a country outside of the U.S. that you know a fair bit of information about. Describe what you know and the source of your information.
- b. If you had 3 days to prepare for a life changing event (new job, move, marriage), what would you do?
- c. How would you sum up a confession of faith in Jesus in 1 sentence?

## Chapter 2

- Did God tell Joshua to send spies in to the land? If not, what are some reasons why he sent spies?
- 2. Why do you think Joshua only sent 2 spies? How long is the mission?
  - Was sending spies out an act of unbelief on Joshua's part? Explain.
- 3. What is significant of Joshua's command that the spies pay attention, spy out "especially Jericho?"
- 4. How successful were the spies on their mission?
- 5. What kind of report did they bring back?
- 6. Why would the spies enter the house of a prostitute? Are there any strategic benefits to staying there?

- 7. Did Rahab have special information that other Jericho-ites did not have about God's hand on the Israelites? What does she know? (Exodus 14-31; Numbers 21:21-35)
- 8. Do we have a sense of how other nations viewed Israelites and God at this time? (See verses 9-11; Exodus 15:15)
- 9. Is there an irony here (See Numbers 13:31-33)
- 10. How many lies does Rahab tell?
- 11. Was Rahab right to lie to the people who came looking for them? Does God condone her lie? (James 2:25, Matthew 1:5)
- 12. Are there times when we should lie for a good reason? (1 Timothy 1:10, Colossians 3:9-10, Proverbs 12:22, Exodus 20:16.)
- 13. Does Rahab express a ture confession of faith? What is it based on? (Romans 10:6, Hebrews 11:16)
- 14. What does hiding spies tell us about Rahab's character? (See Matthew 1:5)
- 15. What risk did Rahab take in hiding the spies? How do you think the King of Jericho would regard her actions?
- 16. Name the conditions the spies required Rahab to follow. Are there any challenges she may have faced meeting them? (*Genesis 19:12-26*)
- 17. Consider who Rahab mentions. Does her choice show the value of family? Are there any people besides family you would include?
