



## Praying for the Lost

---

**+ Ask God to save lost people around the world.**

*What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he has lost one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the open country, and go after the one that is lost, until he finds it (LUKE 15:4)?*

**+ Pray for all the lost people in the world to have the opportunity to hear about Jesus.**

*And He said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation" (MARK 16:15).*

**+ Pray for the lost people around the world to believe in Jesus when they hear the gospel.**

*For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life (JOHN 3:16).*

**+ Thank God for seeking and saving lost people around the world!**

*For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost (LUKE 19:10).*

## Praying for Missionaries

---

**+ Pray for missionaries to grow in their relationship with Jesus by praying and reading the Bible every day.**

*Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me (JOHN 15:4).*

**+ Pray for missionaries to look and act more like Jesus.**

*Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ (1 CORINTHIANS 11:1).*

**+ Ask God to give missionaries the words to speak when they share about Jesus with others.**

*Praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints, and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak (EPHESIANS 6:18-20).*

**+ Pray for missionaries to be strong in the Lord.**

*Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might ... Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm (EPHESIANS 6:10, 13).*
